3) Cdt.

4) Gillingshill.

Cllr Riches will investigate to see what steps are being taken about the disposal of the Nature Reserve.

Fences will need some attention in the future.

Concern voiced about future upkeep of the Reserve.

5) Roads & 6) Councillor's Report.

i) Belliston road has been patched but flooding still needs to be investigated.

ii) Q62 Carnbee – Ovenstone has been patched.

South of Gordonshall junction at old Manse stretch of 20 – 30 m. on programme for repair. Stretch between Ovenstonemuir and main road junction needs radical repair.

iii) Overkellie has been patched.

Scheduled for major repair which will require road closure for 5 days later in year.

Farmers need to know when.

iv) Ditches are a Council responsibility and usually done in winter.

Ditches with grids are regularly inspected.

Are there any that need attention?

v) Balmonth – road sign at main road junction still not replaced.

Telephone cable exposed.

vi) Serious accident at Pittarthie bends.

Excessive speed. Permanent flood there.

Requires sign.

vii) Hedges impede visibility at certain places.

Falside bridge, Colinsburgh crossroad.

Can they be cut back by Council?

Broadband.

There is finance available to employ 2 people to investigate which areas are not covered by BT superfast broadband.

Will cover East Neuk and Howe of Fife.
